After having a child with multiple disabilities, the founders of Home of Hope noticed so many factors affecting the children with multiple disabilities. These factors include but not limited to injustice, neglect, poverty, corruption and lack of knowledge. It's therefore the belief and interest of Home of Hope that the effects of those factors are minimized to improve the livelihood of the children with multiple disabilities to reach their full potential. Home of hope trains communities, families and individuals on the handling and treatment of children with disabilities and it also provides care and support to the children with disabilities both in the home and in the community.

CARE AND SUPPORT

Care is a general responsibility of Home of Hope staff; they ensure that all the children with disabilities in the home are well fed, clean, loved, protected and are given psychosocial support.



PHYSICAL AND OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

Therapy is aimed at promoting functional independence. All the therapy activities are administered by the therapist with help of the caretakers. These activities are done on daily basis at the center, during home visits, outreach clinics and during drop in.

OUTREACH CLINICS/ ASSESSMENT CLINICS

This are carried out in four selected sub counties in the districts of Jinja, Mayuge, Iganga and Kayunga. Clients are assessed for different services offered by HOH. This includes providing epilepsy medication, therapy and referrals for specialist treatment.
